

BOXKITE TO CONCORDE

ONE HUNDRED YEARS OF BRISTOL AIRCRAFT



Boxkite, Brisfit, Bulldog, Blenheim, Beaufighter, Brabazon, Britannia and Concorde – just some of the famous aircraft that have been built by ‘Bristol’ at Filton since February 1910.

A new 128-page, profusely illustrated hardback book will be published in February to mark the centenary of Sir George White forming the British & Colonial Aeroplane Company (BAC), which subsequently became the Bristol Aeroplane Company. The BAC story is recorded through the First World War; the expansion into aero engines; triumph and tragedy between the wars; the twin-engined fighters and torpedo bombers of World War 2; and post-war diversification into helicopters, guided weapons and the huge Brabazon – culminating in the Concorde supersonic airliner.
